## **USA Triathlon State Championships FAQ**

**Residency requirement:** To be crowned State Champion an athlete must be a resident of that state. An athlete who wins the race but does not reside in said state will still receive the Age Group National Championship automatic qualification, but the State Champion will be awarded to the highest placing finisher who has residence in the state.

**Age Group National Championships (AGNC) Qualification:** As the GR Tri is being held before July 1 the top 25% of each age group (or top 5 finishers, whichever is greater) will qualify for AGNC in 2019.

**High School Ages:** USAT defines eligibility for high school students as June 1st after 8th grade graduation until September 1st after Senior year.

**Awards:** USA Triathlon will provide a total of 12 State Championship awards: places 1-3 for High School Boys; places 1-3 for High School Girls; places 1-3 for Overall Adult Male; places 1-3 for Overall Adult Female. To be crowned the state champion, an athlete must meet the high school eligibility criteria or the state residency requirement.

**High School Socks:** Competitors who finish in the top 5 of the high school division will receive USA Triathlon High School Program socks.
